Important Information

Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the summer term. This is our final full term in Hedgehog Class and we are excited about preparing the children for transition into year 1. Our School Value this term is Harmony. We will be looking in our class worship at what the word harmony means to us and how we can encourage harmony in the world as well as nurture it in ourselves. In circles times we will be looking at the Bible verse: "Do unto others as you want them to do to you" Luke 6:31 and how we can live out this truth in our everyday actions.

Please find below some important information regarding any changes to our daily routines;

Healthy Snacks and water bottles

The children still have access to free fruit each day, but are very welcome to bring in their own named snack pots containing a healthy snack for example a cereal bar or crackers (please no chocolate, sweets or crisps). These will be put in the tray in the morning and the pots returned. Please do not provide your child with anything containing nuts as we are a nut free school. Your child must have a named water bottle in school every day. They will be encouraged to drink throughout the day.

Book Bags and Reading

Children will need to bring in their book bags each day. Books are changed once a week. Please speak to Mrs Olsen or Mrs Hall should you have any concerns about your child's reading.

Reminder: Please could the children not bring in additional rucksacks as we are limited on space and the pegs can get easily overloaded. Spare clothes can be kept in a carrier bag on their pegs if necessary.

PE Kits

PE will continue to take place on a Tuesday and Thursday morning. Please can children start to bring these in next week. The children have access to physical development activities throughout the week in addition to scheduled adult led sessions.

Biscuit money

On a Friday the children need to bring in 10p for biscuits at breaktime. Parents often tape the coin to their water bottle to make it easier to find but a named purse in their book bag is also fine. If they forget, they may take a plain biscuit so they don't miss out. The money contributes over the year to enrichment activities for the children.

Wellies and warm coats

The children will need to have a named pair of wellies kept in school every day as we like to make the most of the amazing outdoor space in all weathers and seasons. As the weather heats up please do remember to send children in with sun hats. They do not need their coats on sunny days but a light weather proof jacket is advisable. You need to



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put sun cream on your children in the mornings. They are **not** to have sun cream in school unless this has been specifically agreed with the class teacher.

Communication

If you need to pass on a quick message, please do feel free to catch us at the school gate in the morning but be aware that this is our busiest time settling the children. If it is a longer message or you wish to speak to the teachers about your child you will need to email the office and if necessary, book an appointment. If your child will be picked up by someone else, please let the office know. This will be passed on to us. Most importantly please do not let worries and concerns build up but speak to us as your first action as often these things are best dealt with early. Please be assured we also want the best for your child.
