EYFS – Kandinsky Concentric Circles

“My circles made a flower.” (EYFS)

Year 1 – Eric Carle’s Mister Seahorse

Focusing on colour, pattern and texture.

“I liked making the bright patterns.” (Year 1)

“Mister Seahorse was beautiful.” (Year 1)

Year 2 – Pattern & Colour in Nature

Created textured patterned art inspired by Eric Carle.

(Or you can combine Yr1/2 as one phase if that fits your structure better.)

Year 3 – Insect Observational Drawings

Detailed drawings using line, shade and later adding colour through pencils or watercolours.

Year 4 – Flower Shapes & Tones

Exploring colour, tone, gouache and cross-hatching.

“Gouache is so strong - like painting with cream!” (Year 4)

“My background looked really soft after shading.” (Year 4)
