

Pupil Voice – Art Enrichment Week 2024 Clay, Charcoal, Colour & Hundertwasser

Art Enrichment Week 2024 was a whole-school creative adventure, filled with vibrant colour, texture and bold artistic exploration.

Every child took part in three major projects:

1. A Whole-School Clay & Newspaper Mural

Children worked collaboratively to build a large-scale mural using clay pieces and woven newspaper textures.

“My clay piece went onto the giant picture!” (EYFS)

“It felt good knowing everyone helped make the mural.” (Year 3)

2. A Schoolwide Hundertwasser Project (now displayed in the hall)

Children explored Friedensreich Hundertwasser’s colourful, swirling architectural style and created their own pieces inspired by his work.

“Hundertwasser loves wiggly lines - so did I!” (Year 2)

“My cloth had bright colours and no straight lines.” (Year 4)

3. Charcoal Drawing for the Playground Gallery

Every year group learned charcoal techniques and displayed their finished artworks as part of the temporary outdoor gallery.

“Charcoal made amazing shadows.” (Year 1)

“I liked how messy it was!” (Year 5)

“Our gallery outside looks fantastic.” (Year 6)
