

ACTION PLAN Spring 2026 Based on WHOLE SCHOOL PUPIL VOICE 2026

Priority 1 - Library Development (Whole-school top improvement request)

Why: The overwhelming theme from EYFS–KS2 was: “We want a new library!”

Actions:

- Involve School Council in decisions on layout, book selection and design themes.
- Gather pupil preferences for genres, reading spaces, soft furnishings.
- Create pupil-led “library launch” events.

Success indicators:

- Children report increased enthusiasm for reading.
- Library usage increases.

Priority 2 - Outdoor Learning & Equipment

Why: High pupil interest in more outdoor learning, more equipment, and better use of space.

Actions:

- Identify areas for new equipment or shaded spaces.
- Collect class suggestions for outdoor zones and story spaces.
- Work with staff to introduce more outdoor lessons.

Success indicators:

- New outdoor resources installed.
- Pupils report improved playtimes and outdoor learning.

Priority 3 - Clubs & Enrichment

Why: Children asked for more clubs, enrichment weeks, and visitor events.

Actions:

- Survey pupils on desired clubs (gardening, Lego, science, sports).
- Plan enrichment weeks shaped by School Council ideas.

Success indicators:

- Increased number and variety of clubs.

Priority 4 - Pupil Leadership & Responsibility

Why: Pupils proud of leadership roles; want more opportunities.

Actions:

- Expand responsibilities (Story Helpers, Play Leaders, Worship Leaders).
- Create a Year 6 “Leadership Award” or badge system.

Success indicators:

- More pupils involved in leadership roles.

Priority 5 - Wellbeing & Safety

Why: Children feel safe but want more quiet spaces (esp. KS1).

Actions:

- Develop calm corners and outdoor reading/quiet benches.
- Promote trusted adult awareness.

Success indicators:

- Pupils report high wellbeing and stronger understanding of safety.

Priority 6 - Worship, Values & Courageous Advocacy

Why: Worship is popular; pupils love charity/social action.

Actions:

- Continue whole-school projects (Food Bank, environmental work).
- School Council to suggest themes for Collective Worship.

Success indicators:

- Children articulate GROWTH values confidently.
