Suggestions:

- The Romans wore togas. See if you can make a toga and take a photo of you wearing it! Write some instructions for how you made the toga.
- Romans were great fighters! Their shields were important to them and the colours and symbols symbolised their power and decorated with symbols. Either research about them and write something about them or even make one!
- Who is your favourite illustrator and why? Write a biography about them.
- Recreate some of your favourite illustrations and see if the class can guess the book they came from!
