

Spring Service – March 2023

Our Spring Service 2023 focused on themes of new life, gratitude and rebirth, helping pupils to reflect on the changing seasons and the joy of renewal. Children across the school contributed through songs, poetry and artwork, with class contributions including spring acrostic poems, creative art pieces and reflective writing. Hedgehog class shared the palm branches that they had made. Squirrel Class sang of what Easter means to them. Fox Class explained the Easter message through symbols. Owl Class shared a poem about Palm Sunday that they had written.

Music played a central role, with lively hymns such as *If I Were a Butterfly* and *He's Got the Whole World in His Hands*, encouraging pupils to celebrate individuality and thankfulness. The choir led songs including *Do Re Mi* and seasonal performances, supporting confidence and shared joy.
