

## **ACTION PLAN 2 — Based on WHOLE SCHOOL PUPIL VOICE 2025**

### **Priority 1 - Outdoor Space Improvements**

Why: Pupils loved new gym equipment and looked forward to perimeter fence & EYFS resurfacing.

Actions:

- School Council to monitor and review improvements after installation.
- Collect pupil ideas for additional equipment or zoning.

### **Priority 2 - Safety & Security**

Why: New fence to be installed to improve safety.

Actions:

- School Council “Safety Audit Walk” with staff each term.
- Promote visibility of trusted adults.

### **Priority 3 - Enrichment & Visitors**

Why: Visitors, reading volunteers, trips and clubs make learning “exciting.”

Actions:

- Create a “visitor wish list” generated by pupils.
- Help plan pupil-selected enrichment themes.

### **Priority 4 - Leadership & Roles**

Why: Pupils proud of leadership jobs.

Actions:

- Expand leadership (librarians, eco-champions, worship helpers).
- Develop Buddy system

### **Priority 5 - Collective Worship & Spiritual Life**

Why: Highly valued by pupils.

Actions:

- Involve councillors in selecting songs, readings or prayers.
- Work collectively towards SIAMS mock visit (May) real visit (next year)

### **Priority 6 - Pupil Wellbeing**

Why: Strong care & support, Rainbow Room valued.

Actions:

- Review need for more calm spaces.
- Promote kindness campaigns and friendship projects.

### **Priority 7 - Curriculum Enjoyment & Challenge**

Why: Children enjoy practical learning.

Actions:

- Suggest subjects or topics pupils want explored practically.
- Feed ideas to curriculum lead
