Theme: Want to Talk About It? Making Space for Conversations About Life Online

Children across the school took part in Safer Internet Day 2023, exploring how we can talk openly, safely and confidently about life online. Pupils learned that speaking up, asking questions and sharing worries is an important part of staying safe.

Here is what they said...

EYFS

“I tell a grown-up if something pops up.”

“We learned that not everyone online is who they say.”

Year 1

“I liked talking about games - and what to do if something feels wrong.”

“You can always ask for help.”

Year 2

“We made posters about safe choices.”

“Talking helps you feel better and safer.”

Year 3

“We learned to check before we click.”

“If I’m worried, I can say so - that’s what the day was about.”

Year 4

“We talked about friends online and real friends - they’re not always the same.”

“Asking questions keeps you safe.”

Year 5

“It’s good to talk about online life because it changes so fast.”

“We learned why reporting things matters.”

Year 6

“We discussed privacy, sharing and how conversations build safety.”

“It helped us think about who we can trust.”

Summary – 2023

Children understood that talking openly is the first step to staying safe online. They left the day more confident about asking for help and more aware of how discussion strengthens digital wellbeing.
