### Our Vision for Learning

At Aston Rowant CE Primary School, learning is rooted in our Christian vision of growing together, valuing every child as a unique individual created in God's image. We believe that all children can succeed, regardless of their starting point, and we are committed to providing a curriculum that enables every pupil to flourish academically, socially and spiritually.

Learning at Aston Rowant is purposeful, inclusive and ambitious. It equips pupils with the knowledge, skills and attitudes they need to thrive now and in the future, while nurturing curiosity, confidence and joy in learning.

### Our Curriculum

Our curriculum is carefully designed, well-sequenced and ambitious. It ensures that pupils build secure knowledge over time and are able to make meaningful connections across subjects.

We prioritise:

- Strong foundations in early reading and language
- A broad and balanced curriculum across all subjects
- Rich curriculum enrichment that deepens learning and inspires pupils
- High expectations for all learners, including those with SEND and those who are disadvantaged

Learning is shaped by both national expectations and our local context, enabling pupils to see relevance and purpose in what they learn.

### Inclusive Learning – Growing from Our Starting Points

Inclusion is central to learning at Aston Rowant. We recognise that pupils arrive with different experiences, needs and strengths, and we work hard to ensure that learning is accessible and ambitious for all.

Teachers:

- Use assessment effectively to identify starting points and next steps
- Adapt teaching through scaffolding, modelling and targeted support
- Provide appropriate challenge so all pupils can succeed and deepen their learning

Our approach ensures that pupils with SEND, EAL learners and those requiring additional support are fully included and able to make strong progress alongside their peers.

### What You Will See in Classrooms

When learning is at its best at Aston Rowant, you will see:

- Calm, purposeful classrooms where pupils are engaged and motivated
- Clear explanations and strong subject knowledge from teachers
- Pupils using subject-specific vocabulary confidently
- High-quality questioning that promotes thinking and discussion
- Pupils working independently and collaboratively
- Mistakes welcomed as part of the learning process
- Strong relationships built on trust and mutual respect

Pupils are encouraged to take responsibility for their learning and to develop independence, resilience and confidence.

### Curriculum Enrichment

Curriculum enrichment is a key strength of learning at Aston Rowant. We provide experiences that extend beyond the classroom and bring learning to life.

These include:

- Enrichment weeks (such as Science, RE, Music, Art Enrichment Week and Maths and English Days)
- Educational visits and visitors
- Strong community links, including with our local church
- Outdoor learning opportunities, including use of our grounds and wider environment

These experiences help pupils deepen understanding, build cultural capital and develop curiosity about the world around them.

## **Living Our Values Through Learning**

Learning at Aston Rowant is shaped by our core values:

### **Gratitude**

Pupils value learning opportunities, resources and the contributions of others. They take pride in their work and appreciate the chance to learn new things.

### **Resilience**

Pupils are encouraged to persevere, take risks and learn from mistakes. They develop confidence in overcoming challenges and refining their work.

### **Outreach**

Learning helps pupils understand their role in the wider world. Pupils learn about different cultures, beliefs and communities, developing empathy and respect.

### **Wonder**

Curiosity is actively encouraged. Pupils are inspired to ask questions, explore ideas and develop a love of learning.

### **Trust**

Pupils feel safe to express ideas, take risks and think deeply. They trust themselves, their teachers and one another.

### **Harmony**

Learning is collaborative and respectful. Pupils work well together, valuing different perspectives and supporting one another.

## **Impact**

As a result of learning at Aston Rowant, pupils:

- Make strong progress from their starting points
- Develop secure knowledge and skills across the curriculum
- Become confident readers, communicators and thinkers
- Demonstrate resilience, independence and curiosity
- Show respect for others and the world around them
