

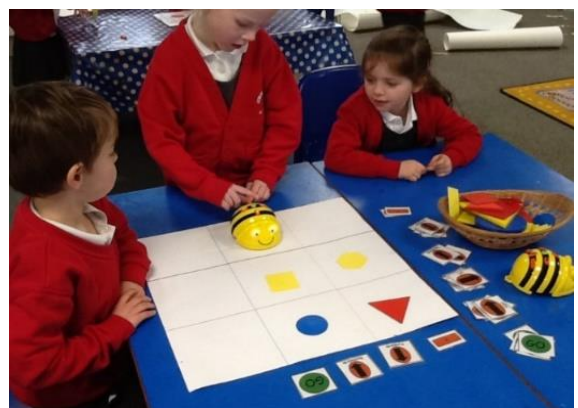
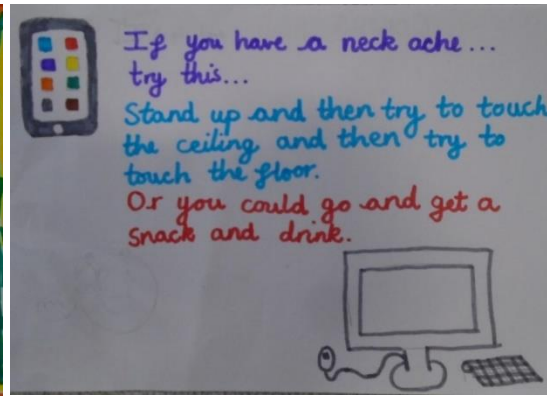
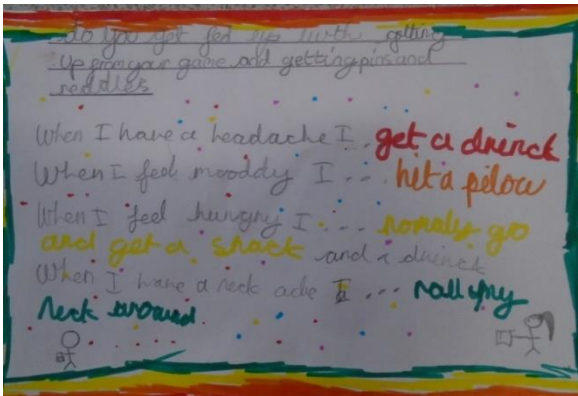
ICT Enrichment Week 7th – 11th February 2022

This week has been our ICT Enrichment Week, and on Tuesday we joined in with the UK, Safer Internet Day. Each year this day explores a new issue or theme which is impacting the lives of young people in the UK. In 2022 the day celebrates young people's role in creating a safer internet and the ways they are shaping the interactive entertainment spaces they are a part of.
