Suggestions:

- If you were creating a map, what other symbols would you include? Can you make a poster explaining them?
- If you could settle anywhere in the world, where would it be and why? Write a leaflet describing it
- Find out the history of a place near where you live: why did people settle there, how has it changed from then to now?
- Write a poem about light and shadow. It could be a rhyming poem, an acrostic poem or free verse.
- Can you make a shadow puppet?
- Make a video of the different shapes you can make with your hands in shadow?
- Research how rainbows are made. Can you write an explanation or draw pictures to explain how they are made?
