Homework and Home Learning support the pupils to grow in experience and skills.

Our aims for Homework and Home Learning:

Homework expectations by class:

EYFS	Reading – 10 minutes per day to an adult <i>Occasional Phonics activities</i> <i>Occasional topic linked tasks</i>
Year 1 & 2	Reading – 10 minutes per day to an adult Spellings/Phonics – tested weekly Maths - weekly Learning Log activity linked to curriculum work <i>Occasional project/topic research tasks – emphasis on independent research</i>
Year 3 & 4	Reading – reading for pleasure book and school set book as possible including regularly to an adult as well as independently Piece of English e.g. SPaG, writing task or comprehension Maths - weekly Spellings – tested weekly <i>Occasional project/topic research tasks – emphasis on independent research</i>
Year 5 & 6	Reading – once a week to an adult then independently at home as much as possible Piece of English e.g. SPaG, writing task or comprehension Spellings – tested weekly Maths – weekly <i>Occasional project/topic research tasks – emphasis on independent research</i>

Other tasks may be given to any pupil for to support learning in school or other opportunities, e.g. competition entries.
