This half term's open-ended task is focussed on our History topic of Stone Age to Iron Age and our Science topic of Rocks and Soil

Choose one of these ideas or you may have something else you'd like to do. Bring your completed project in on the week commencing 15th December when we will share what we have made to the class.

Suggestions:

- Create an acrostic poem about the Stone Age
- Create a quiz about the Stone Age to Iron Age. Can we answer them in class. Remember to have the answers too!
- Create your own fossil. What type of animal could it have been?
- Make Stonehenge! What materials could you use?
- Linked to last term's topic of settlements, could you make a settlement from any of the ages we are studying?
- Become a geologist and dig in some different areas such as your garden or in the hills; are there different rocks there? Write a report about what you have found.
- Become a rock star! Write a rap about the three types of rock!
- Fill a quarter of a small empty water bottle with soil and then the rest of the bottle with water. Shake it well and leave to stand for a few days. What do you notice? What different layers can you see? Draw what you see and write down sentences to describe what you have observed.
